Our flagship event, The Global Leadership Summit (GLS), is an annual gathering that merges expertise from both ministry and the marketplace. Held live in Chicago during the first week of August each year since 1995, the Summit is recorded using high-definition and advanced video technology.

After the live broadcast across the USA, the content is meticulously curated and video-casted as conferences or training sessions in over 120 countries globally.



In each participating country, the event is facilitated by a team of well-trained professionals who deliver the Summit's content in an effective, live environment. The GLS features presentations from top-rated world-class speakers, including former U.S. President George W. Bush, former UK Prime Minister Tony Blair, leadership expert John Maxwell, Bishop T.D. Jakes, movie producer and actor Tyler Perry, former Secretary of State Condoleezza Rice, current President of Malawi Lazarus Chakwera, Alex Njombe - KPMG Managing Partner in Tanzania, leadership expert Jim Collins, Zimbabwean billionaire Strive Masiyiwa, Gideon Mzonya -CEO of LIFE Ministry Tanzania, Sheryl Sandberg, former COO of Facebook, Laszlo Bock, Google's HR boss, and Erin Meyer, professor at INSEAD. The Summit has also featured Angela Ahrendts, Senior Vice President of Retail at Apple, along with numerous Harvard professors, academics, researchers, and bestselling authors from around the world.

Local events are further enriched by accredited live speakers from each respective country, ensuring that attendees benefit from both international and regional expertise. Since its inception, GLS has been translated into over 60 languages, including Swahili, and has reached more than 120 countries, including Tanzania. With an impact on over one million people worldwide, it stands as the longest-running and most extensive leadership event of its kind.

# GLN TANZANIA HOW WE WORK

Since 2013, The GLN Tanzania has been conducting leadership events in four formats:

- **GLS Premier:** The flagship event, known as the Global Leadership Summit, focuses on corporate leaders, business leaders, religious leaders, academics, and entrepreneurs. This event is a paid event where participants pay premier fees to attend.
- GLS Emerging Leaders: This event targets university and college students, aged 18 to 35 years, aiming to cultivate leadership skills among the emerging leaders of tomorrow.
- GLS Special Edition: Focused on special groups within the community, this event is tailored to address specific challenges faced by professionals such as HR, Accountants, Pastors, and Doctors. The content is curated to meet the unique needs of these groups.
- **GLS Next Gen:** Targeted at the next generation of leaders under the age of 18, this event aims to raise awareness and develop leadership skills in young leaders.

- To release women leaders to use their leadership gifts, to work well alongside men, and to use their voices to transform their communities




